EQUIPMENT AND COURT SPECIFICATIONS

Ball Size:

6u: size 4

8u: size 5 (27.5)

10u: Boys: size 6 (28.5) Girls: size 5 (27.5)

12U: Boys: size 7 (29.5) Girls: size 6 (28.5)

A different size ball can be used if both coaches agree prior to start of the game. If coaches do not agree, than the stated size ball must be used.

Rim Height:

6u & 8u: 8ft

10u & 12u: 10ft

3 Pointers:

6u & 8u: no 3pts (2 points only)

10u & 12u: 3 pointers are allowed

Game Structure:

6u: 4v4

- Six 5 minute periods
- 1 minute between periods
- 5 minute halftime
- No Free Throws
- All goals are 2 points
- No 3 point goals
- 1 time out per half, clock continues to run.
In the last minute of the last period clock will stop.
- Coin flip to start the game.
Winner takes possession from 1/2 court.

Game Structure:

8u:

- Four 10 min quarters
- 1 minute between quarters
- 5 minute halftime
- No Free Throws
- All Goals are 2 pts
- No 3 pt goals
- 1 time out per half. Clock continues to run except in the last minute of the 4th quarter, clock will stop on dead ball.
- Coin Flip will start the game.
Winner takes possession from 1/2 court.

10u:

- Four 10 min quarters
- 1 minute between quarters
- 5 minute halftime
- Free throws 1pt
- All goals 2 pts
- 3 point goals
- 1 time out per half. Clock continues to run except in the last minute of the 4th quarter, clock will stop on a dead ball in the final minute only.
- Jump Ball to start the game.

12u:

- Four 10 min quarters
- 1 minute between quarters
- 5 minute halftime
- Free Throw 1 pt
- All goals 2 pts
- 3 point goals
- 2 time outs per half, no carry over. Clock continues to run unless in the 4th quarter, clock will stop on a dead ball in the final minute only.

Time outs: 1 minute timeouts.

Injuries stop the clock immediately.

Back Court Timeline:

6u, 8u, 10u: (10 seconds)

12u (8 seconds)

Subbing can only be done on a dead ball (Fouls, Timeouts or injuries), not during live play.

NO DOUBLE ROSTER within the same division will be allowed. You may double roster players if it is in a different age division playing up.

Defense play:

6U:

- Man to man and zone defense allowed
- No press defense, no double team and no stealing unless it is a pass.
- Block shots are good only if the defender jumps straight up with no downward motion of the arms to the shooter.

8u, 10u and 12u:

- man to man and zone defense allowed
- Press defense allowed **only in the second half**
- Double teaming allowed
- Stealing from the dribbler allowed

Fouls:

6U: Fouls will be called, but players will not foul out of the game.

8u, 10u, 12u: 5 foul out rule for the game.

Playoffs:

Brackets will be determined by regular season record.

Pending on how many teams are you in your bracket. Each division will be split into level of play.
Pro (Top Tier), Collegiate (Middle Tier), Varsity (Bottom Tier)

If there are 3 teams in the bracket. The top seed will sit out of the playoff with automatic bid in the Championship game. The other 2 teams will play and winner plays in the championship game.

On Championship Game day only teams that make it to the championship will play on this day.

All teams will play a minimum of 6 games in the season.

Scores will be kept from day 1 of play to get an accurate playoff bracket.
